

## **Conflict Minerals Policy**

Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act requires certain reporting of the origin of Conflict Minerals (i.e., tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold – 3TG) used in the products or the production of products. The goal of this Act is to identify the countries where these "conflict minerals" have been sourced from in order to determine if any have originated from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or the adjoining countries (collectively "Covered Countries"). This is in an effort to reduce the ongoing conflict and humanitarian disaster in the DRC as it is partly funded by the trade in ores from which 3TG minerals are derived.

**Echjay Forgings Pvt Ltd** being manufacturer of forgings by HOT FORMING, in plastic stage, which do not change the chemical analysis of input RAW MATERIAL, has adopted this Conflict Minerals Policy in order to ensure that:

- 1. RAW MATERIAL we receive from suppliers are free of conflict minerals, or
- 2. If any of our products contain conflict minerals, as necessary to the functionality of our product, they were sourced from a conflict-free country.

We have implemented a Conflict Minerals Program wherein regular inquiries are made to our Raw material suppliers for the origination of any conflict minerals that may be present in the products provided to us.

Echjay Forgings Pvt Ltd will not purchase raw materials that contain conflict minerals, sourced from Covered Countries and we require our Raw material suppliers to provide transparent conflict minerals information regarding the raw material they sell to us.
